Application for the 6th European Month of Photography Berlin

What it is about

For the sixth time, the largest German Photography Festival will take place in Berlin. In past years, more than 100 institutions (museums, culture institutions, galleries, embassies, political representatives from the Federal States of Germany, photo schools, project rooms) present exhibitions and events pertaining to historical and contemporary photography in an international context. The European Month of Photography Berlin will play a large role for Europe in 2014. What we understand today as various turning points in European history, such as how upheavals and disruption are experienced, which utopias shape the image of the future, or how the other, the foreigner, enriches European culture will be the focus of the photography biennale. This year's theme Umbrüche und Utopien. Das andere Europa (Upheavals and Utopias. The Other Europe), is an invitation to an exciting journey of discovery through yesterday and today.

When

The 6th European Month of Photography will open at the Martin-Gropius-Bau on October 16, 2014 and will last exactly a month until November 16, 2014.

If you want to participate

Interested institutions can apply with one or more projects in order to participate in the 6th annual European Month of Photography. The submitted exhibition should of course pertain to this year's theme. The application deadline for the applicable documents is March 1, 2014. At the beginning of April, a jury, under the direction of the new curator Frank Wagner, will decide which projects will be accepted into the festival program. Unfortunately, individual photographers cannot participate. All of the accepted projects will be presented in the 256-page festival catalogue (German/English) with ample pictorial material. The website www.mdf-berlin.de offers extensive information (events, tickets, etc) about the individual festival exhibition.

Where is this taking Place?

Along with exhibitions that are spread throughout the entire city, there are also central exhibitions of the partner cities of Berlin, Bratislava, Budapest, Ljubljana, Luxemburg, Paris and Vienna. These exhibitions will be located in the first floor of the Martin-Gropius-Bau and will open together with the 6th European Month of Photography on October 16. The exhibitions will be on view until December 15, 2014 – entrance is free! In the days after the opening, a diverse and exciting program is planned.
