Start of the Applications for the Portfolio Reviews

European Month of Photography Berlin 2016

On the occasion of the **EMOP Opening Days** of the **European Month of Photography Berlin 2016**, **C/O Berlin** is offering **Portfolio Reviews** over a period of two days. They will take place from **September 30th to October 1st, 2016** in the **Museum für Fotografie / Helmut Newton Foundation**. Interested photographers can submit their **applications** online from **August 8th to September 4th, 2016**.

Present your photographs in one-on-one discussions, explain your image ideas in person and benefit from the knowledgeable opinions of 32 international experts! For Portfolio Reviews, 80 photographers, artists, and students will have the chance to present their photographic work to world-renowned experts in 15 minute-long individual discussions – including photographers, curators, art directors, journalists and gallery owners.

How are the reviews done? During registration, interested photographers can book three or six discussions and select their preferred reviewers. The Portfolio Reviews are divided into four time blocks over two days – each day from 11:00 am to 2:30 pm and 4:00 pm to 7 pm.

How do I apply? Photographers can submit their portfolio with up to 20 photos (5 MB) in digital format. In addition to the portfolio, a short project description in German and English with a maximum length of 300 characters per language as well as a short resumé and the completed online form available on the website must be filled out. From the submitted applications, a pre-selection of 80 photographers will be made.

What do the Portfolio Reviews cost? An application fee of 90 euros for three discussions or 150 euros for six reviews will be charged.

When can I apply? From August 8th to September 4th, 2016

The **EMOP Berlin – European Month of Photography** is Germany’s biggest photo festival and presents the broad spectrum of historical and contemporary photography. Museums, cultural institutions, galleries, project spaces, embassies and photography schools in Berlin and Potsdam will present numerous exhibition projects and events throughout October. The expert jury of EMOP Berlin has selected 130 exhibition projects from 120 institutions for the festival program this year. Classics will be shown alongside positions that are bound to offer surprises for connoisseurs – with well-known names alongside emerging artists.

The selection of the participants from the EMOP Berlin - European Month of Photography 2016 will not only bear witness to a thematically diverse but also institutional and conceptual variety. Formats range from exhibitions in outdoor areas and large museum presentations to brilliantly researched individual and group presentations in galleries and project spaces, as well as impressive contributions from the many foreign cultural institutions and embassies residing in the city, city art and cultural offices. The creativity of numerous photography schools in Berlin and their obvious participation in the festival is a distinguishing feature of EMOP Berlin.
